- Award \$43,500 in scholarships to deserving McCloud seniors to further their education
- Award \$54,964 in direct aide to classroom teachers K-12 through Teacher Grants
- Donate \$2,700 to the Academic Letter Jacket program
- Provide lunch for ACT testing and snacks for State testing
- Provide Teacher Appreciation Week goodie bags to High School and Junior High teachers and staff
- Secure \$4,000 in grants to support the secondary food pantry
- Distribute \$4,000 for coats and shoes in partnership with the McCloud Alumni Association
